

## Action Fund Grant Allocations: October 2019

The following grants were announced in October 2019. The total amount allocated was £35,319.

**1. The Gifted Organisation Limited - Butterfly Extra - £4,578**

Sessions for girls at pupil referral units to help build resilience and reduce risky behaviours.

**2. The Living Room - Wrong to Right - £4,991**

Breaking the Cycle of Addiction and Crime. Training and awareness raising to increase relevant referrals from agencies associated with Criminal Justice System.

**3. Dacorum Community Safety Partnership - 'Dacorum if you see it, say it' - £5,000**

Booklet and Community Safety twice yearly newsletter. Uses campaign approach including a wide variety of articles on crime reporting / prevention, safeguarding, mental health.

**4. Herts Young Homeless - Live Life - £5,000**

Break cycle of crime by expanding their successful project to Watford for young people (16 to 24) who have been homeless - nearly half of whom have a criminal past.

**5. Bishops Stortford Street Pastors - £4,000**

Expanding the number of volunteers and patrolling new areas to try and protect young people from drug dealing.

**6. Welwyn Hatfield Inter Faith Group - 'Whisper' Welwyn Hatfield Interfaith Peace Education Resources - £2,750**

Volunteers of different faiths visiting secondary and primary schools and colleges in the area.

**7. Habs Family Support Team - Healthy Relationships, Healthy Futures - £4,000**

To deliver preventative programmes to young people before things 'go wrong'.

**8. Hertfordshire Practical Parenting Programme - Research Project - £5,000**

The Impact of Unresolved Childhood Trauma on Modern Day Parenting - revisiting case files to look for evidence of cycle of abuse.
