## **1 INTRODUCTION**

The PCC joined the Local Government Association approximately 3 years ago when fire governance was put forward by the government for PCCs to consider taking responsibility. There is an annual subscription and the PCC has to decide whether it remains a benefit to remain a member.

## **2 FINANCIAL AND LEGAL IMPLICATIONS**

The payment for 2020/21 is £3,480.75. This sum appears to have been invoiced in December 2019 but has not been seen previously so it may have been sent to the Constabulary address shown for payment on the invoice. This does mean there is a potential issue that the subscription is in fact for last year's membership and another will be due imminently.
