

Decision by the Police and Crime Commissioner for Hertfordshire

Item: Road Safety Fund Bid

Date: 15 April 2021

Decision: The paper was approved at the above Decision-Making Meeting.

The allocation of £20,838 from the Road Safety Fund was agreed to pilot a new piece of automated camera equipment in Barley for 3 years to enable the production of warning letters to speeding vehicles.

Background: Over many years Barley Parish Council have raised speeding concerns on the B1368 and B1039 with Hertfordshire County Council (HCC), the Constabulary and the Commissioner.

Local residents of Barley are concerned about safety within the village around anti-social road use as evidenced by the number of enquiries into the Commissioner's inbox over many years. The proposals will reduce anti-social road use by highlighting to drivers that they are entering a village environment with many pedestrians and will thereby encourage appropriate driver behaviour.
