

Decision by the Police and Crime Commissioner for Hertfordshire

Item: Southern and Eastern Regional Police Insurance Consortium S22 Agreement

Date: 04 May 2021

Decision: The paper was approved at the above Decision-Making Meeting.

The signing of the Southern and Eastern Regional Police Insurance Consortium (SEERPIC) S22 agreement was approved.

Background: SEERPIC has been in existence for 20 years, operating as an insurance purchasing consortium, but also as a vehicle to lever improvements of managing risk across the 10 participating forces / 20 corporations sole with the aim of securing best value of insurance for members.

The S22a reflects the SEERPIC model and its governance, giving clarity on roles and responsibilities, and introducing references to specific SEERPIC roles funded by the 10F. It also formalises arrangements around the running of the Board and outlines the approach termination and withdrawal that gives transparency and clarity to the arrangements and protection to all participating members.
