

Decision by the Police and Crime Commissioner for Hertfordshire

Item: Serious Violence Priority Area Project

Date: 27 May 2021

Decision: The paper was approved at the above Decision-Making Meeting.

£80,000 from the 2021/22 Community Safety & Criminal Justice budget was approved to support a proposal submitted by all 10 Districts/Boroughs to deliver a project against the Commissioner's 2021/22 priorities within the strategic plan theme of 'Tackling Serious Violence & Safeguarding Vulnerable People'.

Background: As part of the Commissioner's move towards a commissioned approach to grant allocation the Commissioner requested proposals against the following 2021/22 priorities:

Priority 1A: Implementation of a cost effective/sustainable Hertfordshire model for delivering 1:1 support to young people/young adults identified as at high risk of gang involvement/serious violence.

Priority 1B: Widening the scope of existing multidistrict Youth Crime Panels to enable them to cover more crime types.

The only proposal submitted by the deadline was one that is led by Three Rivers District Council on behalf of all 10 districts/boroughs in Hertfordshire.
